

Music Study Schedule:

1: Introduce the composer! Share a picture of the composer and add the composer to your Book of Centuries. Read a story about the composer – either a living book or biography.

Music Study In 4 Simple Steps:

1: Select a specific composition to give focused listening to.

2: Listen to the composition with full attention.

3: Discuss the piece. Tell the title and any additional information you want to share.

4: Between music studies, play all the compositions multiple times.

Here are some questions you may wish to discuss together:

- Do you like the composition?
- What did the music make you think of?
- Do you have a favorite part of the song?
- What kinds of instruments did you hear?
- What was the tempo(s) of the composition?
- What was the volume(s) of the instruments?
